INCH Needs Your Help

According to the 2016 Census data, homelessness and inadequate dwellings has risen by **5%** across Australia since 2011. The 2016 homeless rate was 1 person in every 200 people.

The rate of homelessness in Queensland is significantly higher than in southern states. There are **more than 21,500 people who are homeless every night** in Queensland.

Adequate, safe and affordable housing is important to everyone, as we all know the expression **"There is no place like Home"** - a home is more than a shelter or a physical dwelling, it's a place to belong, it shapes who we are, it directly impacts on our physical and mental health, it effects relationships with our family, friends and the community and its determines our quality of life.
